



Code of Conduct for Members

In order that we might promote a Christian witness both among Anchor Homeschool Group members and to those outside of Anchor and in the interest of safety and unity, we believe that certain codes of conduct, behavior and dress should be understood and agreed upon by all members. The following rules apply to any Anchor sponsored activity.

1. **Conduct** - Members will act with civility in both word and deed towards one another. The use of inappropriate, loud or boisterous language and behavior is prohibited. Members will refrain from any violent or dangerous behavior such as hitting, kicking and wrestling. No name calling will be allowed. For safety, there will be no running inside the building. Everyone will respect the building and its property.
2. **Dress Guidelines** – All pieces of attire should be of modest length and fit. All tops must be long enough to cover midriff and a high enough neckline to cover the chest area when bending or stretching. No undergarments should be visible. No inappropriate images, messages or slogans.
3. **Supervision** – Parents are responsible to supervise their children. If a child is not behaving in class, they will be removed from class and placed in the care of their parents. If a parent is not present, he/she needs to make prior arrangements with another adult to supervise their children.
4. **Accountability** – Parents will instruct their children that any adult has the right to monitor the behavior of children around them and if necessary, verbally correct them and/or remove them and place them in the care of their parents.
5. **Electronics** – As a courtesy to other members laptops, electronic tablets, cell phones and other portable electronics should be placed on vibrate, silent or turned off while at an Anchor Homeschool Group activity. Cell phone conversations are restricted to an area where it will not disrupt the classroom instruction (empty classroom with door closed). The use of Electronic devices is prohibited for all adults and students during Anchor Homeschool Group classes unless instructed by an instructor.

Member's Participation in co-op

- All members are expected to be on time. Opening is at 9:15am on co-op days. The doors will lock at 9:30am then the member will need to coordinate with the hall monitor to gain access to the building.
- All members are volunteers and everyone is required to participate in either instructing, assisting or another area of service. Instructors will provide a class description, supply list and fees.
- Instructors are required to find their own substitute beginning with your class assistant or from the list of subs. You are to provide the lesson plans to your class.
- All of our teaching materials will be creation based and will require approval by the board.

I have read and agree with these rules. Any infractions of these rules can result in removal from the Anchor Homeschool Group with no refund of membership dues, class fees etc.
